## Supporting the Mission

Rosetta Family Foundation is a nonprofit organization developing a new six-bed Adult Residential Facility in Los Angeles for adults with developmental disabilities. The proposed program is designed to provide twenty-four hour non-medical residential care and supervision in a safe, stable, community-based home for adults whose needs can be appropriately met in a structured residential setting.

Community support and grant funding help Rosetta Family Foundation prepare for the responsible opening of a residential home focused on safety, supervision, daily living support, and long-term residential stability. The program is being developed within the planned scope of an Adult Residential Facility and in alignment with applicable residential care requirements.

## Program Model

Rosetta Family Foundation is developing a small residential home intended to provide twenty-four hour non-medical care and supervision for adults with developmental disabilities.

The proposed program is designed to provide:

- safe and stable housing
- supervision for safety
- assistance with activities of daily living
- structured routines
- medication assistance as permitted by regulation
- coordination with authorized service providers
- a community-based living environment

Future admissions will occur only after required approvals, screening, and program opening. Residents will be accepted only if their needs can be safely met within the approved service model, staffing structure, and non-medical scope of care.

The program is not designed to provide emergency shelter, detoxification services, correctional placement, skilled nursing care, or locked supervision.

## How Funding Is Used

Grant funding and charitable support help Rosetta Family Foundation prepare for the opening and lawful operation of a new six-bed Adult Residential Facility.

Funds may be used for:

- residential home setup and preparation
- beds, furniture, and household equipment
- safety and accessibility improvements
- fire and life-safety readiness
- food and daily living supplies
- staff training and preparation
- program development and compliance costs
- resident support supplies
- facility maintenance and repairs
- supplies needed for residential operations

All funds will be used solely for lawful charitable purposes and in accordance with nonprofit and applicable residential care requirements.

## **Community Partnerships**

Rosetta Family Foundation values partnerships that help expand access to safe, community-based residential care for adults with developmental disabilities who require supervised living.

Support may come from:
